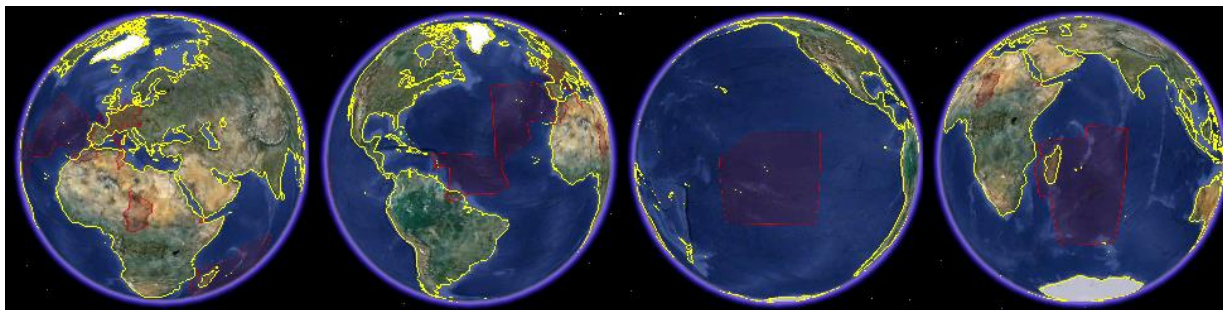

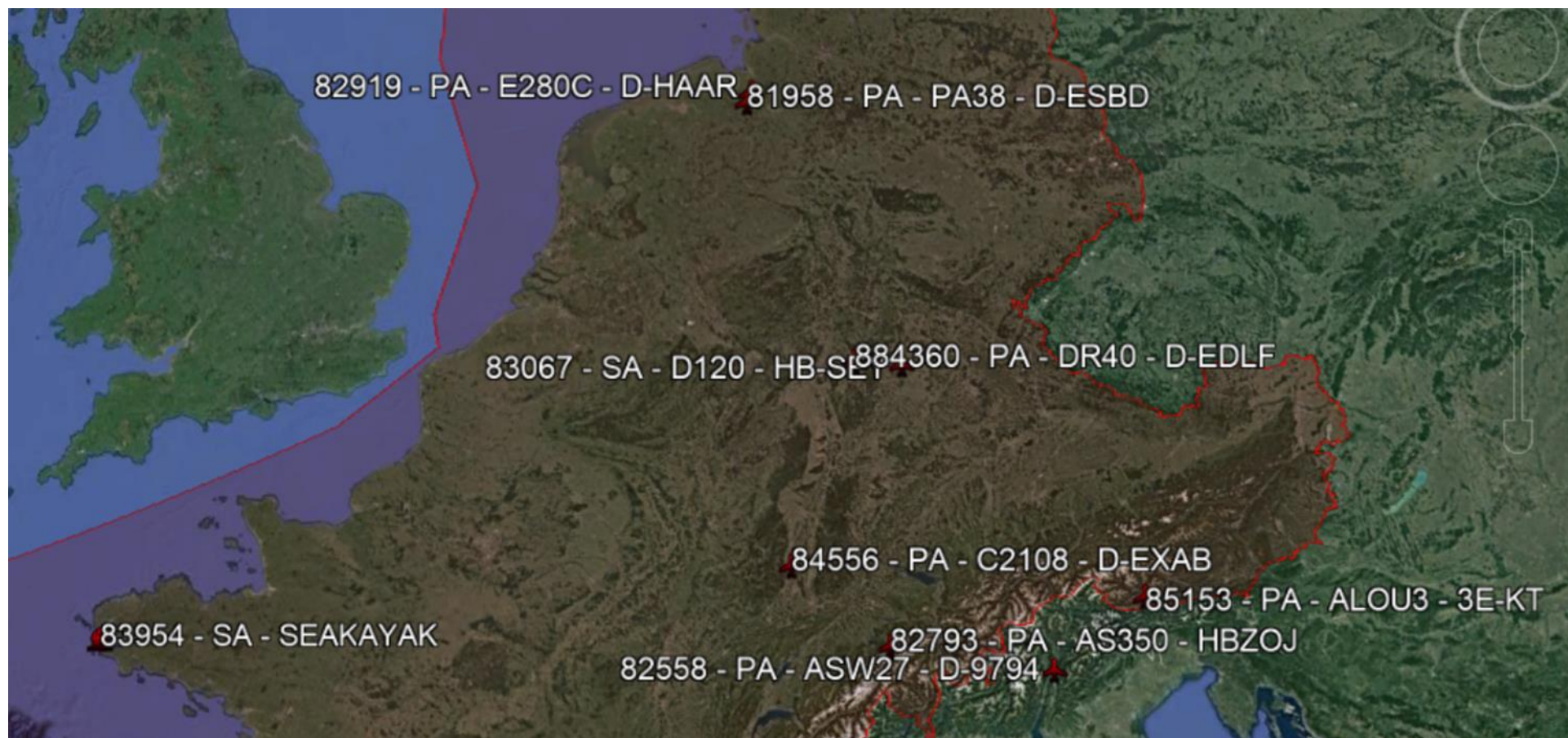

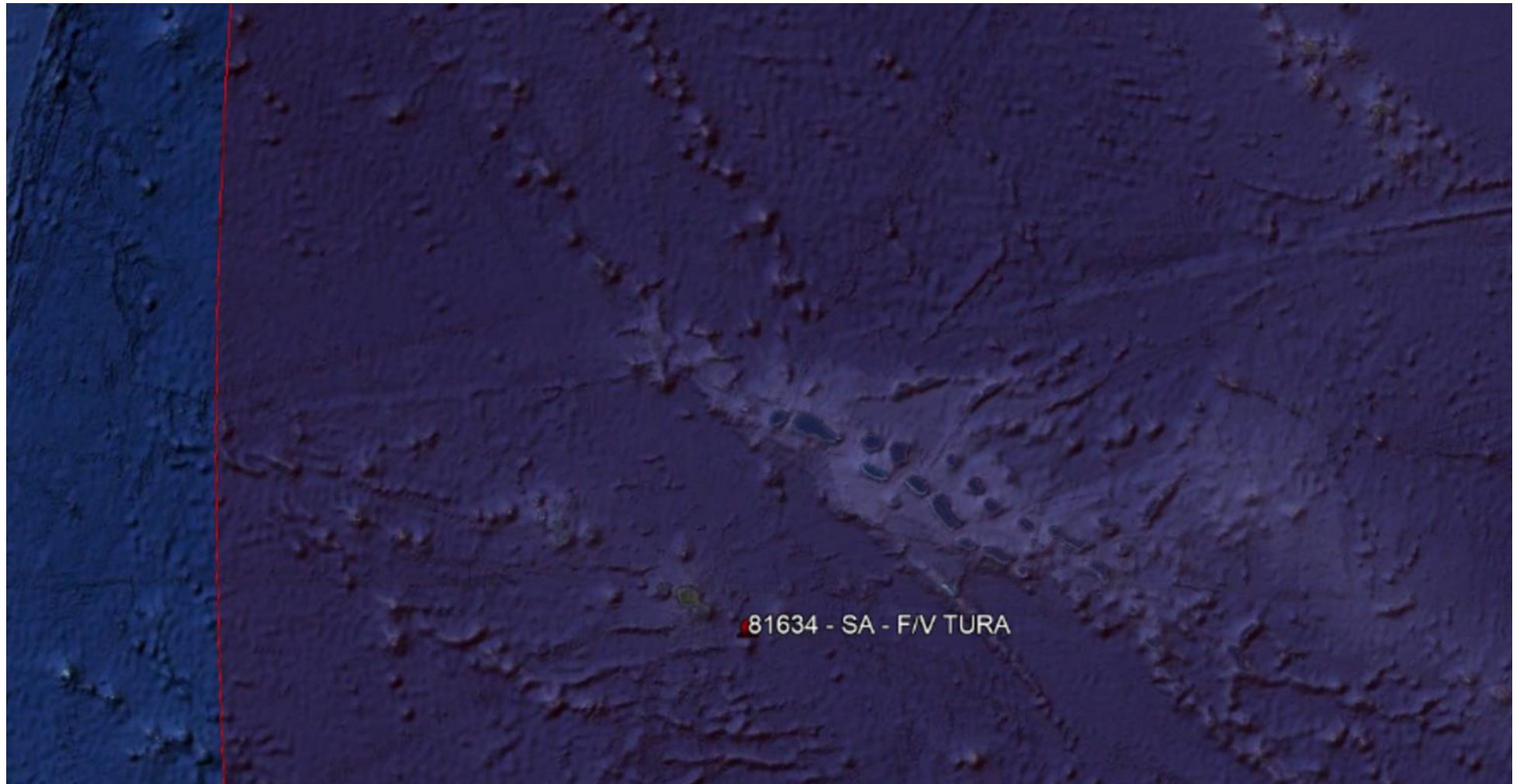




SAR EVENT – FMCC AREA – INDIAN OCEAN
